### **Psychological Safety as the Engine of Change, Quick-Tutorial (4 min)**

Change doesn't fail because of technology, it fails when people don't feel safe to speak up. This video shows why psychological safety is the true engine of successful change. You'll learn how trust, empathy, and open dialogue help teams move from silence to shared learning.
